

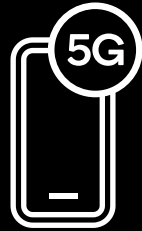

IP leadership

Qualcomm innovations led 5G's first release, enabling its core functionality — throughput, latency, capacity, reliability, spectrum, and more. This leadership has continued in each subsequent release, adding value to our portfolio. 5G leverages 4G's foundations, which Qualcomm also led from its inception. Our patent portfolio also includes valuable non-essential cellular innovations and leading portfolios in video coding, Wi-Fi, modem to antenna, positioning, camera and imaging, compute, and other areas. Qualcomm innovations are widely deployed, and we have issued patents in more than 100 countries and regions worldwide.

Widely licensed

Qualcomm has been actively licensing patents to the mobile handset industry for over 30 years. With over 200 5G licensing agreements, our 5G innovations are the most widely licensed in the industry — including multiyear patent license agreements with leading handset OEMs.

Cellular SEP-only license

We offer handset licenses covering our worldwide portfolio that includes our patents that are essential to 3GPP cellular specifications at a royalty rate of 3.25% of the net selling price for branded 5G-capable handsets.

Portfolio license

We also offer handset licenses covering our worldwide portfolio that includes our cellular standard-essential patents, other non-cellular standard-essential patents and patents not essential to standards at royalty rates of 5% of the net selling price for branded 5G-capable handsets.

Rights under Qualcomm's non-essential patents may be negotiated at Qualcomm's discretion based on several considerations, including whether the counter-party is competing fairly with Qualcomm's licensees.

Device cap

All 5G handset licensing programs include a per device cap.
